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Reasons for not making the following transcripts and/or recordings accessible upon request:

- *Muḥammad Ṣalāḥ*: He made a number of corrections in the transcript and asked us to stick to that text. Not publication concerns the recording only. Accessibility is only possible with his explicit consent and might be only granted after a well motivated request through Arab-West Report about why this is needed. AWR will pass the request on to him for him to decide. Accessibility is also possible after his death.
- *Anonymous former member of al Watan*: Same reason as above. Moreover, he has asked to be kept anonymous. Not publication concerns the recording only. If we make the recordings available he risks losing this anonymity (voice recognition). Accessibility is only possible with his explicit consent and might be only granted after a well motivated request through Arab-West Report about why this is needed. AWR will pass the request on to him for him to decide. Accessibility is also possible after his death.
- *Khaled Mansour* - the interview took place after June 30, 2013. He knew the interview was being recorded and the transcript would be published (in 2013). On numerous occasions, Mansour calls what happened a coup and he is extremely critical of anyone that helped the army implement their plan. He even mentions al-Sisi specifically. He talks about a struggle, and that they will continue to oppose those who side with the coup. He also explains how they will not stand by and watch as they go back to the ways of the old regime pre-Januari 25, 2011. Access to this recording should be highly restricted. We cannot contact him and thus no requests can be passed on to him. Accessibility is possible after his death.
- *Dr. Wafā' Hafnī, Dr. Sanā' and Dr. Ishtihād* – They knew the interview was recorded and that a transcript would be made. However with the changes that took place after July 2013 we believe that publishing this interview could possibly be harmful to them. We have not been able to contact them and thus no requests can be passed on.

All interviewees agreed to us recording the interviews. We sent all the transcripts after the interviews for approval. Some approved while others did not respond, for those we use the term "No objection received." Most transcripts can be made accessible upon request but we fear that the interviews with Khaled Mansour, Dr. Wafā' Hafnī, Dr. Sanā' and Dr. Ishtihād could possibly endanger them. We believe we have an ethical obligation to not put people in danger, even if there is only a very small chance of that happening.
